<p>Statistics</p> <p>Pupils should be taught to:</p> <p>Shows curiosity about numbers by offering comments or asking questions.</p> <p>Compares two groups of objects, saying when they have the same number.</p> <p>Shows an interest in number problems.</p> <p>Experiment with their own symbols and marks, as well as numerals.</p>	<p>Statistics</p> <p>Pupils should be taught to:</p> <p>Uses the language of 'more' and 'fewer' to compare two sets of objects.</p> <p>Finds the total number of items in two groups by counting all of them.</p>	<p>Statistics</p> <p>Pupils should be taught to:</p> <p>Interpret and construct simple pictograms.</p>	<p>Statistics</p> <p>Pupils should be taught to:</p> <p>Interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables</p> <p>Ask and answer simple questions by counting the number of objects in each category and sorting the categories by quantity</p> <p>Ask and answer questions about totalling and comparing categorical data</p>
