- **Nursery & Reception** produce a wonderful weekly newsletter with all the exciting information about what they are working on and how you can best support your child during the week.
- **Year 1** have been very busy learning all about <u>'The Ugly Five'</u>. They have become expert researchers and created a fact file for a chosen animal. This fact file was created on the Chromebooks where children had the opportunity to develop their technology skills. The children produced some fantastic work which showcases their detailed knowledge about the five animals.

In maths we have been revising our ability to count up in 2's, 5's and 10's. It has been a challenge when starting from a number other than zero however the children have powered through and shown great motivation.
