






## Properties of Materials



wood:
hard, stiff,
strong, opaque,

into any
shape.



glass: waterproof, transparent, hard, smooth.



plastic:
waterproof,
strong, can
be made to be
flexible or stiff,
smooth or rough.



metal: strong, hard, easy to wash.



paper: lightweight, flexible.



cardboard: strong, light, stiff.



fabric: soft, flexible, hard-wearing, can be stretchy, warm, absorbent.



rubber: hard-wearing, elastic, flexible, strong.
